

Candidate Integrity Tracker December 2023

Integrity Insights

Across December 2023, we have data from 128,616 assessments.

From December 2023 relative to December 2022, we saw mean scores decrease by **-3.66%.** This is entirely consistent with the normal variations that we see from year to year.

There continues to be no evidence of cheating or inflated scores due to generative Al.



Of Interest

Examining the data further, we see that mean scores for December 2023 are 1.24% higher than for November 2023, well within normal observed variations.

Comparing pass rates, the data show pass rates again *reduced* by -6.22% in December 2023 relative to December 2022.

With mean scores moving within a standard range over several months, but broadly consistent overall, and pass rates reducing year on year, this is more strong and consistent evidence that generative AI is not enabling candidate cheating in the way that some feared.
